1. Hillary Chance – Certified Paramedic

Inspection(s) and Violation(s): Department staff investigated allegations of regulatory violations involving Chance. Department staff determined Chance committed misconduct, as defined by statute and regulation, in that Chance created a substantial possibility that death or serious physical harm could result from her actions or inactions. Further, Department staff determined Chance failed to provide a patient emergency medical treatment of a quality deemed acceptable by the Department, including the failure to meet generally accepted standards for provision of care.

Enforcement: The Department notified Chance that it was considering enforcement action. The Department and Chance agreed to resolve this matter though a Consent Order which was executed on June 13, 2024. Within six months from execution of the Consent Order, Chance agreed to successfully complete a state-approved paramedic refresher class, an in-person class on Advanced Medical Life Support, and an Advanced Cardiac Life Support course. Chance further agreed to a demotion to a basic EMT and a suspension of her paramedic certification for twelve (12) months, with six (6) months held in abeyance.

Prior Orders: In May 2024, Department staff issued an order suspending Chance's certificate pending investigation of this matter.
