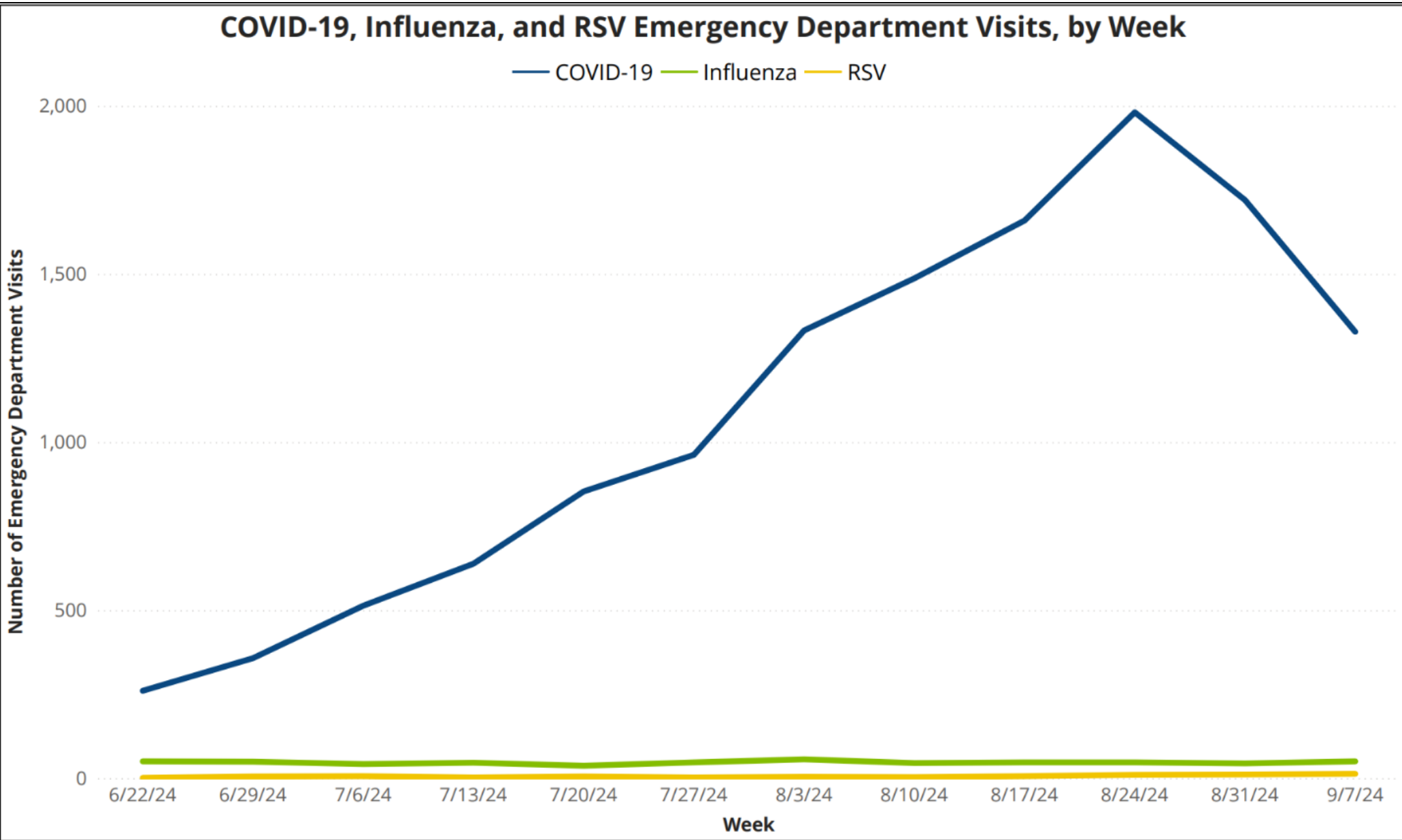
SC MMWR Week 36: September 1, 2024 to September 7, 2024
