Awards are subject to receipt of required additional information and final budget approval. Applicants will be contacted for the information.

This is a Notice of Intent to Award grant funds for the FY2025-RFGA-DC-501 and becomes the official statement of award effective March 14, 2025, unless otherwise suspended or cancelled. Final awards will be contingent on the execution of a grant agreement and satisfactory completion of any necessary negotiations with the Department. Revisions to proposals and budgets may be required. Award amounts will be at DPH's discretion based on application score, projects proposed, number and demographics of population(s) to be served, budget review, and funding availability. The amount of each award, based on the anticipated available grant year funding, is expected to range up to \$37,500 per year for two (2) years. This notice is not an approval of the proposed budget or of any specific expenses. Only allowable costs consistent with the approved budget will be compensated.

Persons who dispute the Grant Awards must follow the dispute resolution procedures set forth in Attachment 5 of the document entitled "Request for Grant Applications (RFGA)", Agency Funding Number Opportunity FY2025-RFGA-DC-501. **No other mechanism exists to dispute the awards under this grant program as it is exempt from the South Carolina Procurement Code Section 11-35-10, et seq.**
