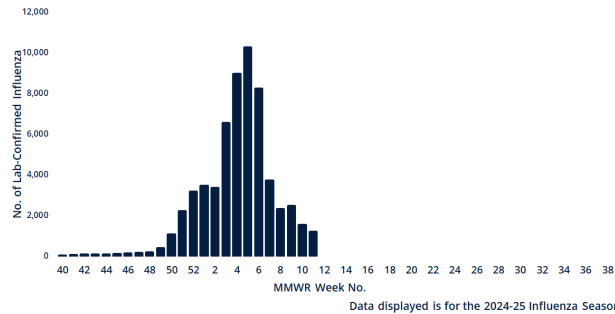

Virologic Surveillance

This week **1,185** lab-confirmed tests were reported. In the current flu season, there have been **60,040** lab-confirmed tests reported.

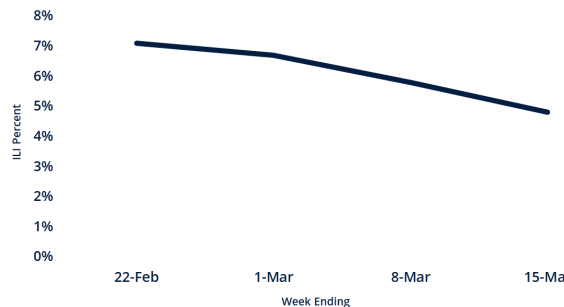


Influenza-Associated Hospitalizations

This week **249** influenza-associated hospitalizations were reported by **64** hospitals. The cumulative hospitalization rate is **151.7 per 100,000**. In the current flu season, there have been **7705** influenza-associated hospitalizations.

Influenza-Like Illness Surveillance

The percent of patient visits to sentinel providers for an influenza-like illness (ILI) was **4.8%**, which is **above** South Carolina's baseline (**3.2%**). The ILI activity level overall was **high**.



Influenza-Associated Deaths

This week, **37** influenza-associated deaths were reported; however, **26** deaths occurred during previous weeks. The cumulative mortality rate is **3.9 per 100,000**. In the current flu season, there have been **236** influenza-associated deaths.

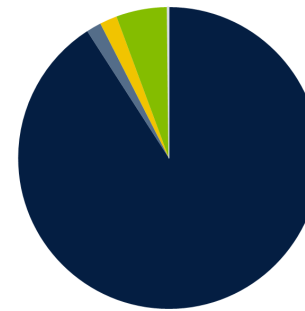

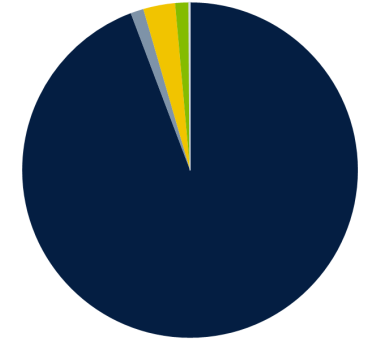

Week ending 3/15

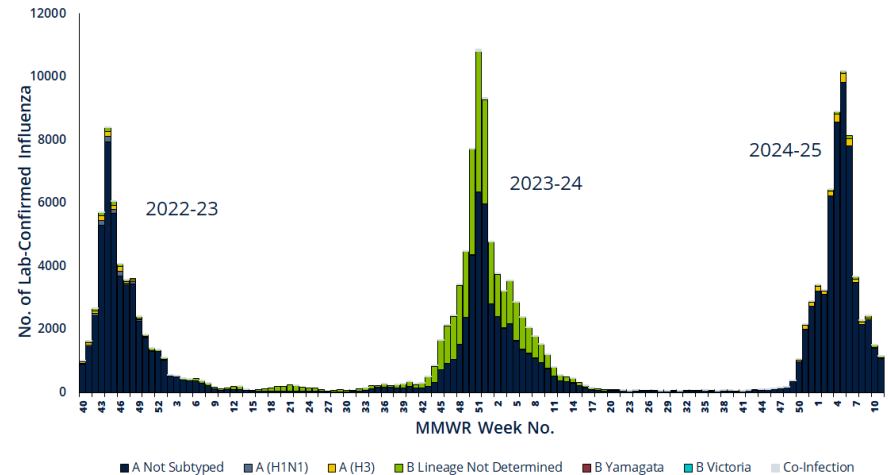

Laboratory-Confirmed Influenza Cases, 2022-23 Season to Present



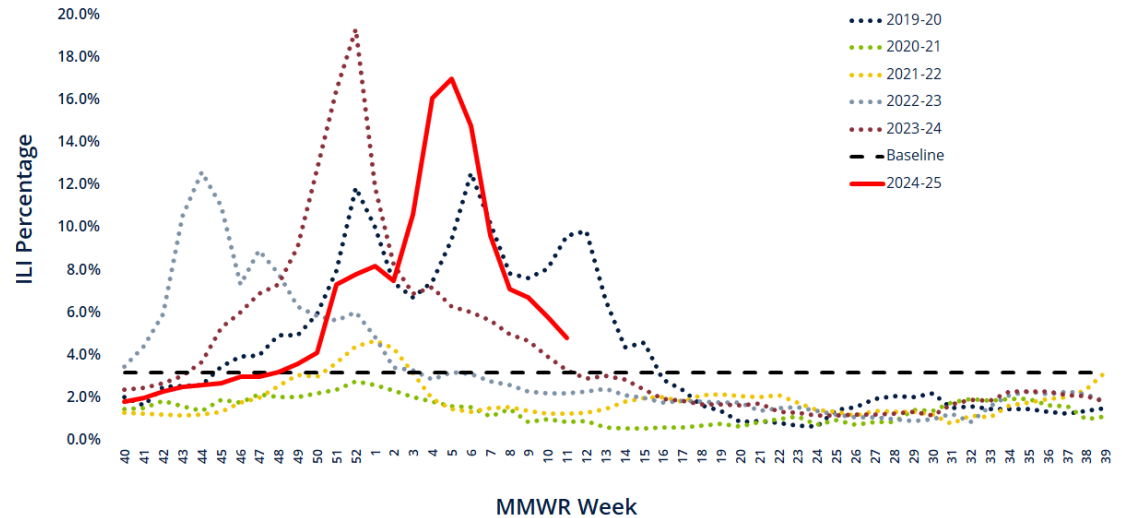
Influenza-Like Illness (ILI) Surveillance

This week, the ILI activity level was **high** and **4.8%** of patient visits to SC ILINet providers were attributed to an influenza-like illness. This is **above** the state baseline of **3.2%**.

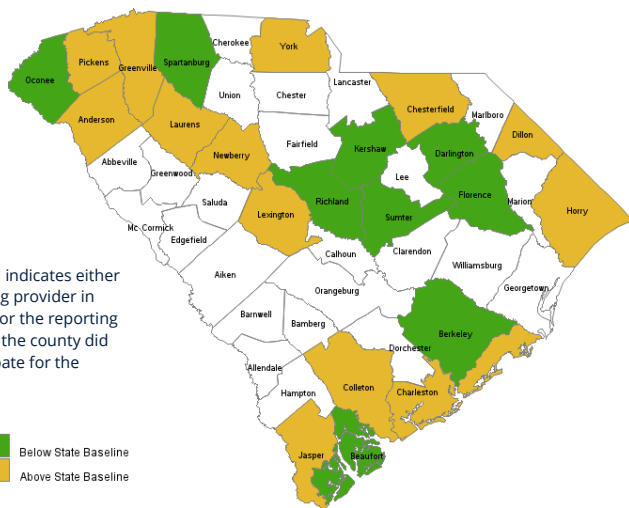
Reports were received from providers in **22** counties, representing all DPH Public Health regions.

ILI percentage is dependent upon the number of reporting providers and/or can vary by disease activity or the number of providers submitting reports.

Percentage of Influenza-like Illness (ILI) Visits Reported by Sentinel Providers for Past and Current Seasons



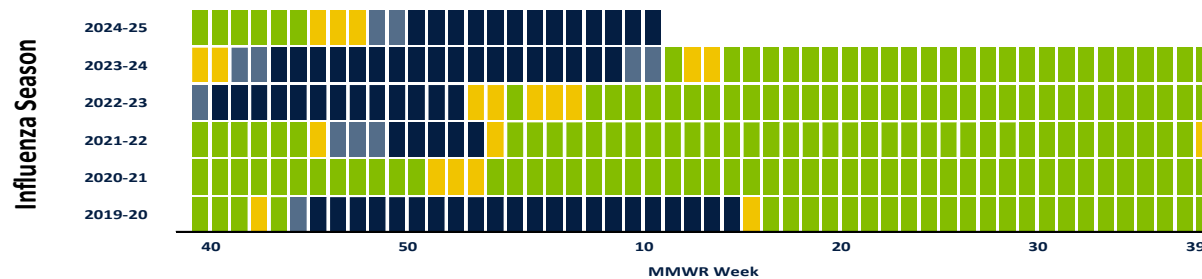

State ILI Activity Level by MMWR Week, 2017-18 Influenza Season to Present



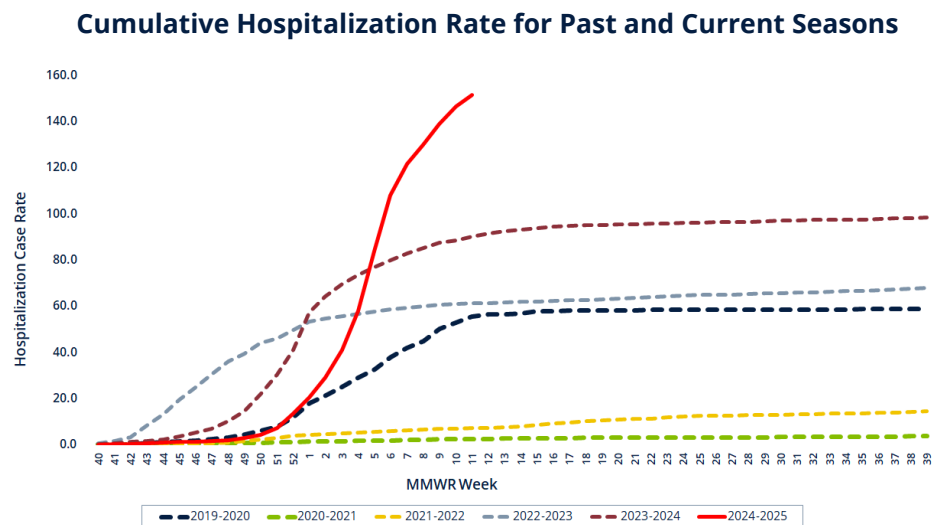
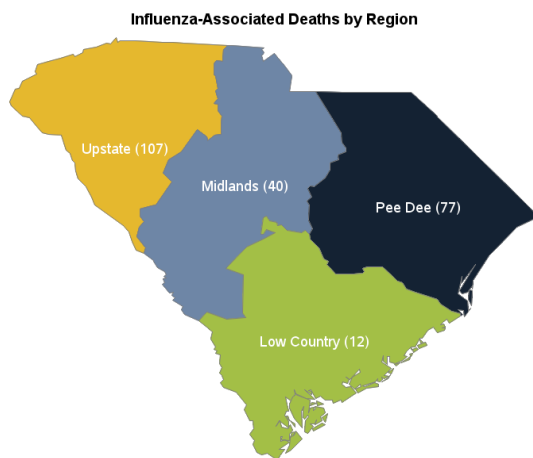
