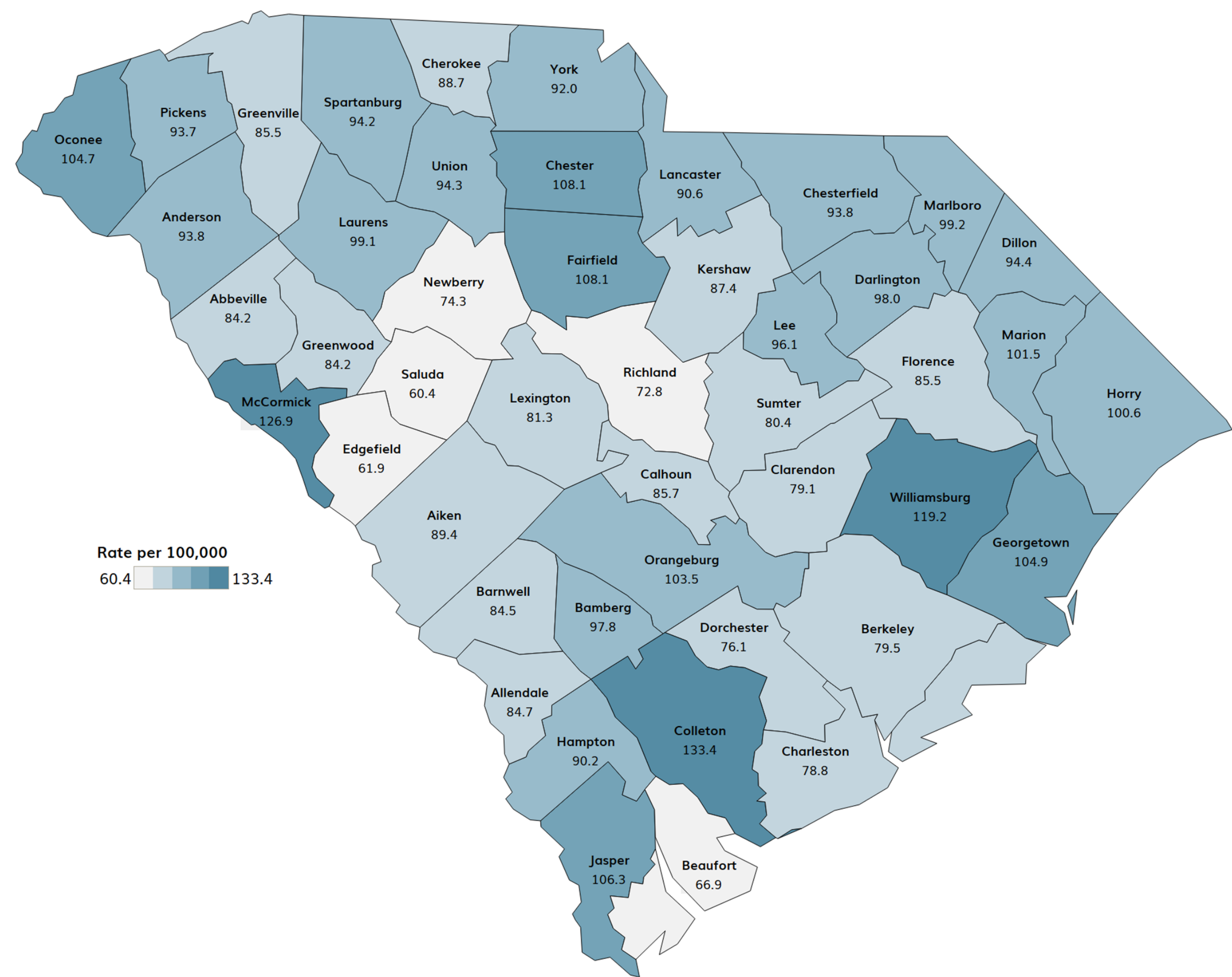

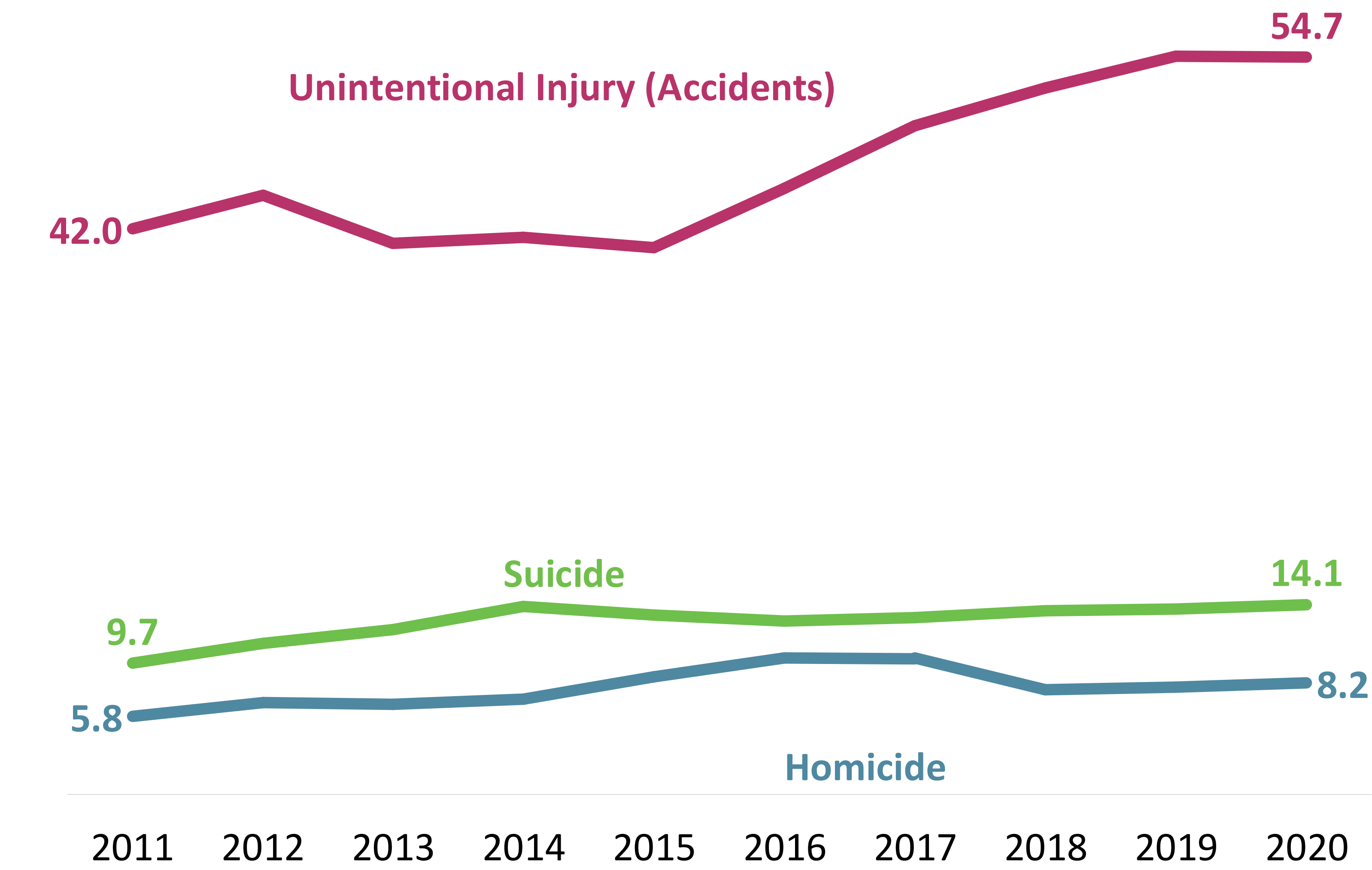
Overall Injury

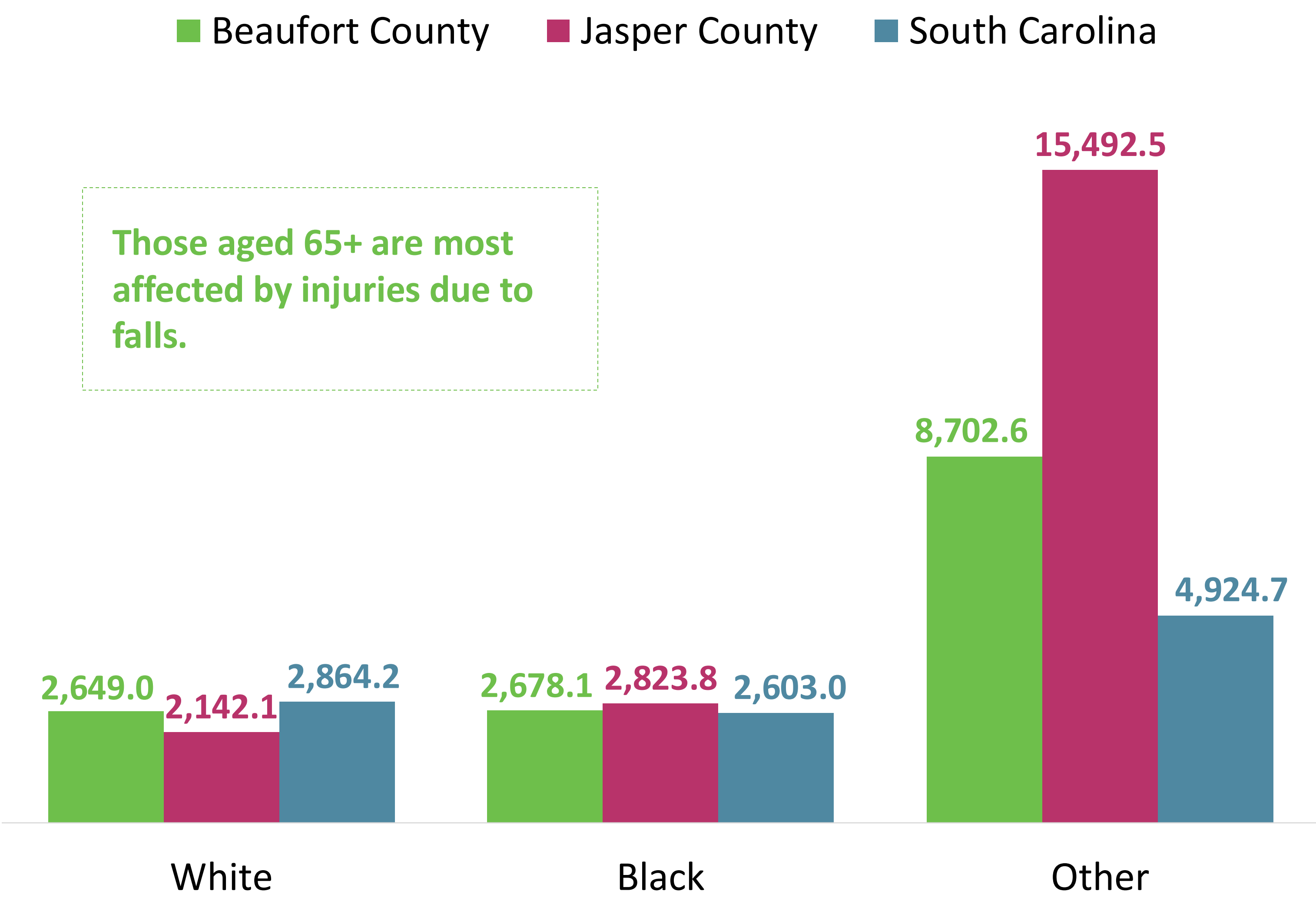
Leading Cause of Injury Deaths in Beaufort and Jasper Counties, by Age Group

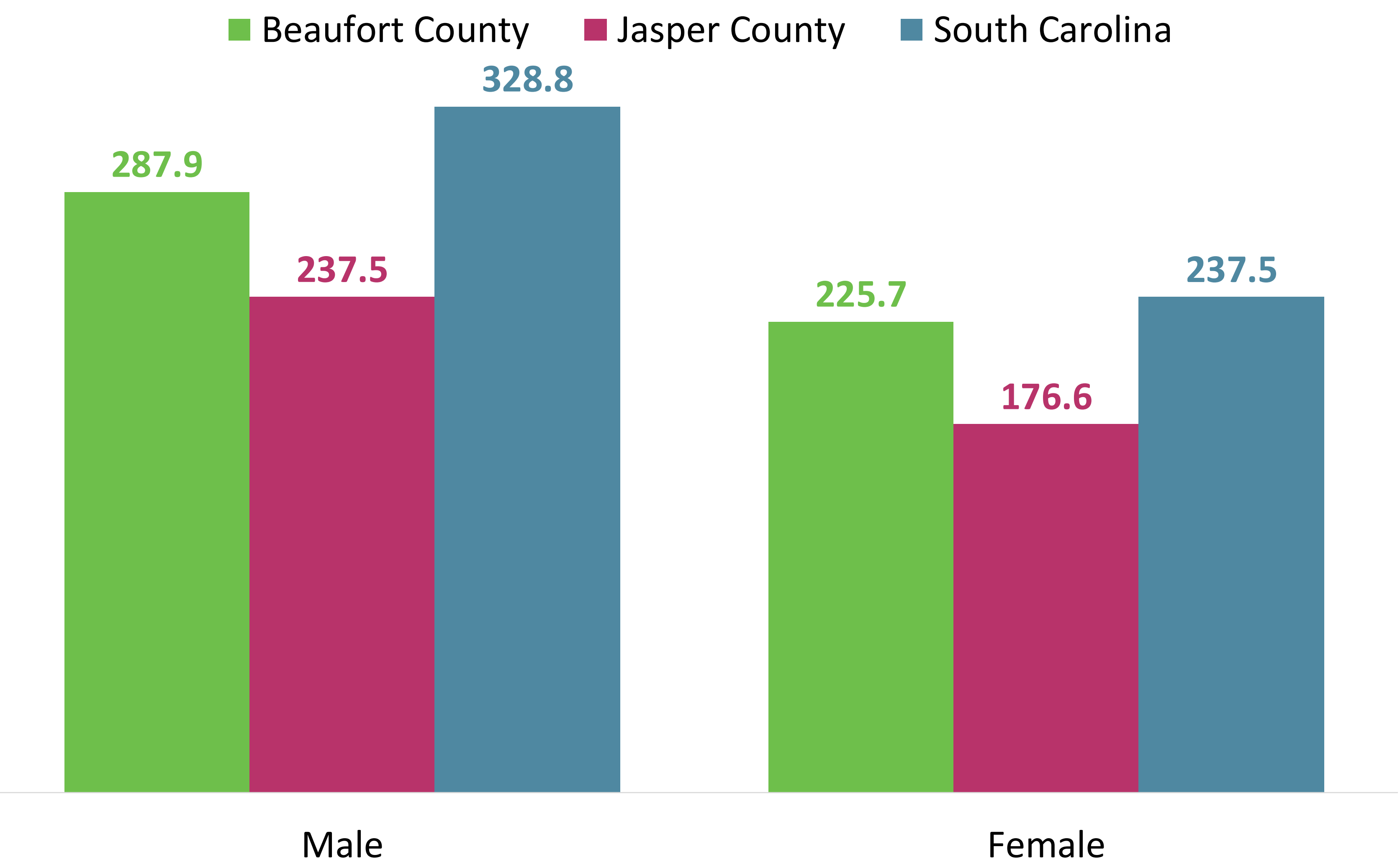

Rate per 100,000 population



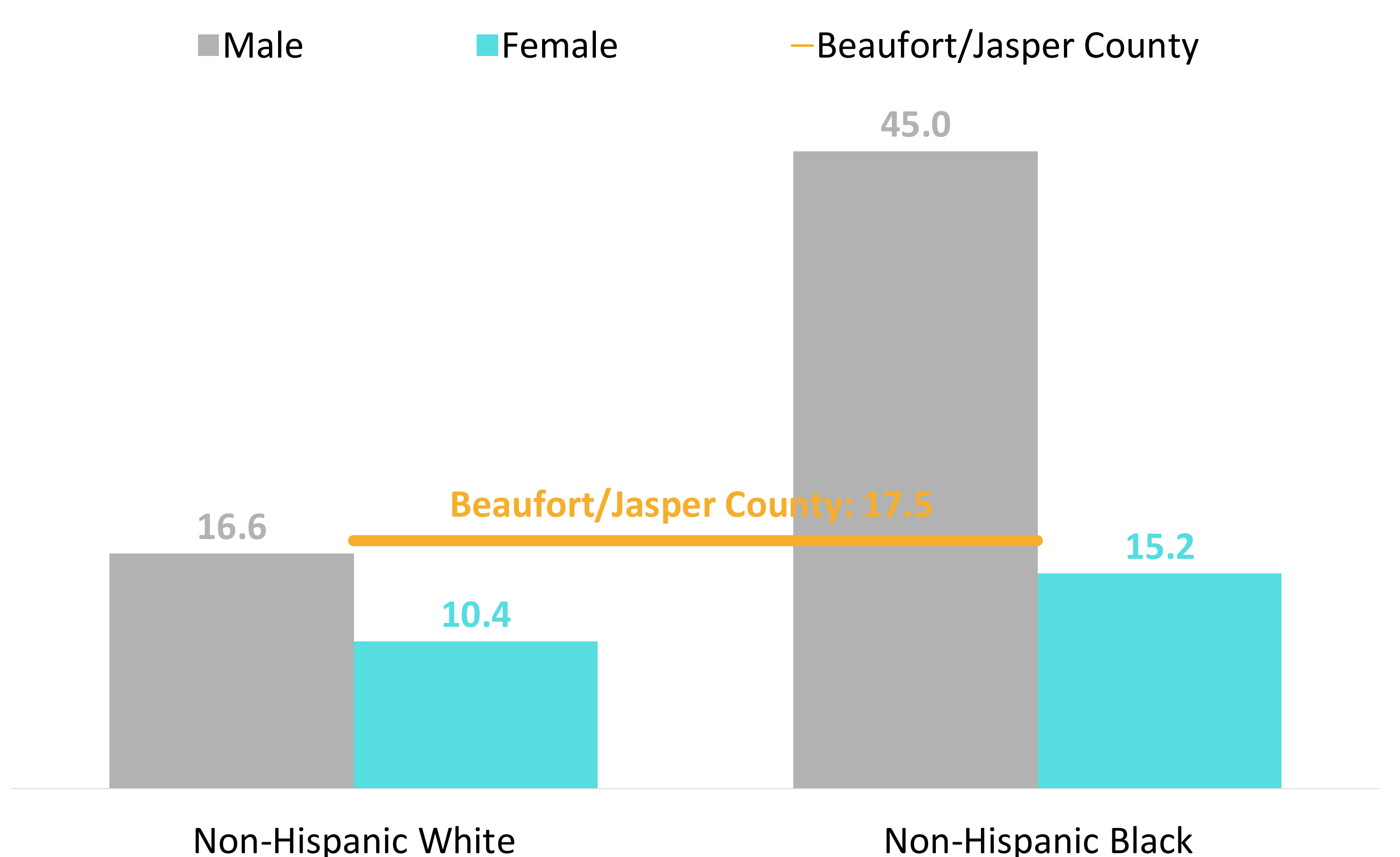
