South Carolina reported sporadic activity this week


Virologic Surveillance

This week **48** lab-confirmed tests were reported. In the current flu season, there have been 62,227 lab-confirmed tests reported.

Influenza-Like Illness Surveillance


The percent of patient visits to sentinel providers for an influenza-like illness (ILI) was **1.6%**, which is **below** South Carolina's baseline (**3.2%**). The ILI activity level overall was **minimal**.

Influenza-Associated Hospitalizations

This week 9 influenza-associated hospitalizations were reported by 44 hospitals. The cumulative hospitalization rate is 162.5 per 100,000. In the current flu season, there have been 8251 influenzaassociated hospitalizations.

Influenza-Associated Deaths

This week, **0** influenza-associated deaths were reported. The cumulative mortality rate is 6.2 per 100,000. In the current flu season, there have been **315** influenza-associated deaths.
