This week **19** lab-confirmed tests were reported. In the current flu season, there have been 62,355 lab-confirmed tests reported.


# Influenza-Like Illness Surveillance


The percent of patient visits to sentinel providers for an influenza-like illness (ILI) was 0.9%, which is **below** South Carolina's baseline (**3.2%**). The ILI activity level overall was **minimal**.

## **Regional Influenza Activity**



### **Influenza-Associated Hospitalizations**

This week **10** influenza-associated hospitalizations were reported by 56 hospitals. The cumulative hospitalization rate is 163.4 per 100,000. In the current flu season, there have been 8299 influenzaassociated hospitalizations.

#### Influenza-Associated Deaths

This week, **0** influenza-associated deaths were reported. The cumulative mortality rate is **6.2** per 100,000. In the current flu season, there have been **315** influenza-associated deaths.
