Fire Response Training including hands-on fire extinguisher training is available through the DPH Fire and Life Safety Section to facilities at no cost. The training is hands on, conducted in a safe and positive manner using realistic props and suitable for each individual facility type. Training is in small groups of 3-4 participants for 10-15 minutes per group.

Identifying Fires Notifying Emergency services Activating the fire alarm system Evacuating residents, staff and visitors Identifying exits Importance of unobstructed exits Checking doors for heat Importance of closing the door How to indicate residents' rooms have been evacuated Accountability for residents' staff and visitors Safe dispersal/assembly area When to fight the fire When not to fight the fire Smoke conditions Fire Drill Procedures Choosing the correct fire extinguisher Understanding R.A.C.E and P.A.S.S
