

## Recommended Supplies When Staying in a Medical Equipment Power Shelter

Durable Medical Equipment (DME) - O2 Concentrator, back up battery(s) for equipment, wheelchairs, CPAP Machines, etc.
Consumable Medical Supplies (CMS) - tubes, bandages, catheters, syringes, etc.
Prescription medications and/or insulin - enough for two weeks if possible.
Non-prescription medications - pain relievers, laxatives, antacids, etc.
Eyewear - contacts, saline, glasses, reading glasses.
Infant formula/food, bottles, diapers, etc.
Personal hygiene/feminine products.
Complete changes of clothes for each person (and jackets/coats if applicable).
Service animal supplies (if appropriate).
Cash and/or credit cards.
Cell phone, charger and any back up batteries.
Important documents- Driver's license, medication list, <sup>a</sup> ¢; ¦ y@nsurance information, wills, etc.
Emergency contact numbers.
Pen and paper.
