



Recommended Supplies When Staying in a Medical Equipment Power Shelter

- ☐ Durable Medical Equipment (DME) - O2 Concentrator, back up battery(s) for equipment, wheelchairs, CPAP Machines, etc.
- ☐ Consumable Medical Supplies (CMS) - tubes, bandages, catheters, syringes, etc.
- ☐ Prescription medications and/or insulin - enough for two weeks if possible.
- ☐ Non-prescription medications - pain relievers, laxatives, antacids, etc.
- ☐ Eyewear - contacts, saline, glasses, reading glasses.
- ☐ Infant formula/food, bottles, diapers, etc.
- ☐ Personal hygiene/feminine products.
- ☐ Complete changes of clothes for each person (and jackets/coats if applicable).
- ☐ Service animal supplies (if appropriate).
- ☐ Cash and/or credit cards.
- ☐ Cell phone, charger and any back up batteries.
- ☐ Important documents- Driver's license, medication list, ^a & i ||y@nsurance information, wills, etc.
- ☐ Emergency contact numbers.
- ☐ Pen and paper.
