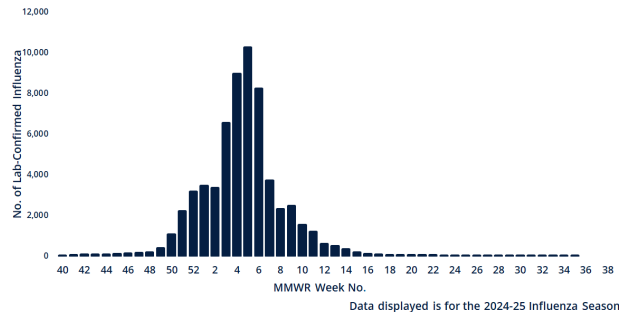

## Virologic Surveillance

This week, **13** lab-confirmed tests were reported. In the current flu season, there have been **62,501** lab-confirmed tests reported.

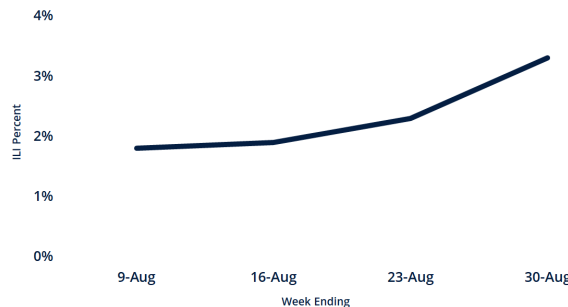


## Influenza-Associated Hospitalizations

This week, **11** influenza-associated hospitalizations were reported by **53** hospitals. The cumulative hospitalization rate is **164.8 per 100,000**. In the current flu season, there have been **8368** influenza-associated hospitalizations.

## Influenza-Like Illness Surveillance

The percent of patient visits to sentinel providers for an influenza-like illness (ILI) was **3.3%**, which is **above** South Carolina's baseline (**3.2%**). The ILI activity level overall was **low**.



## Influenza-Associated Deaths

This week, **0** influenza-associated deaths were reported. The cumulative mortality rate is **7.1 per 100,000**. In the current flu season, there have been **359** influenza-associated deaths.
