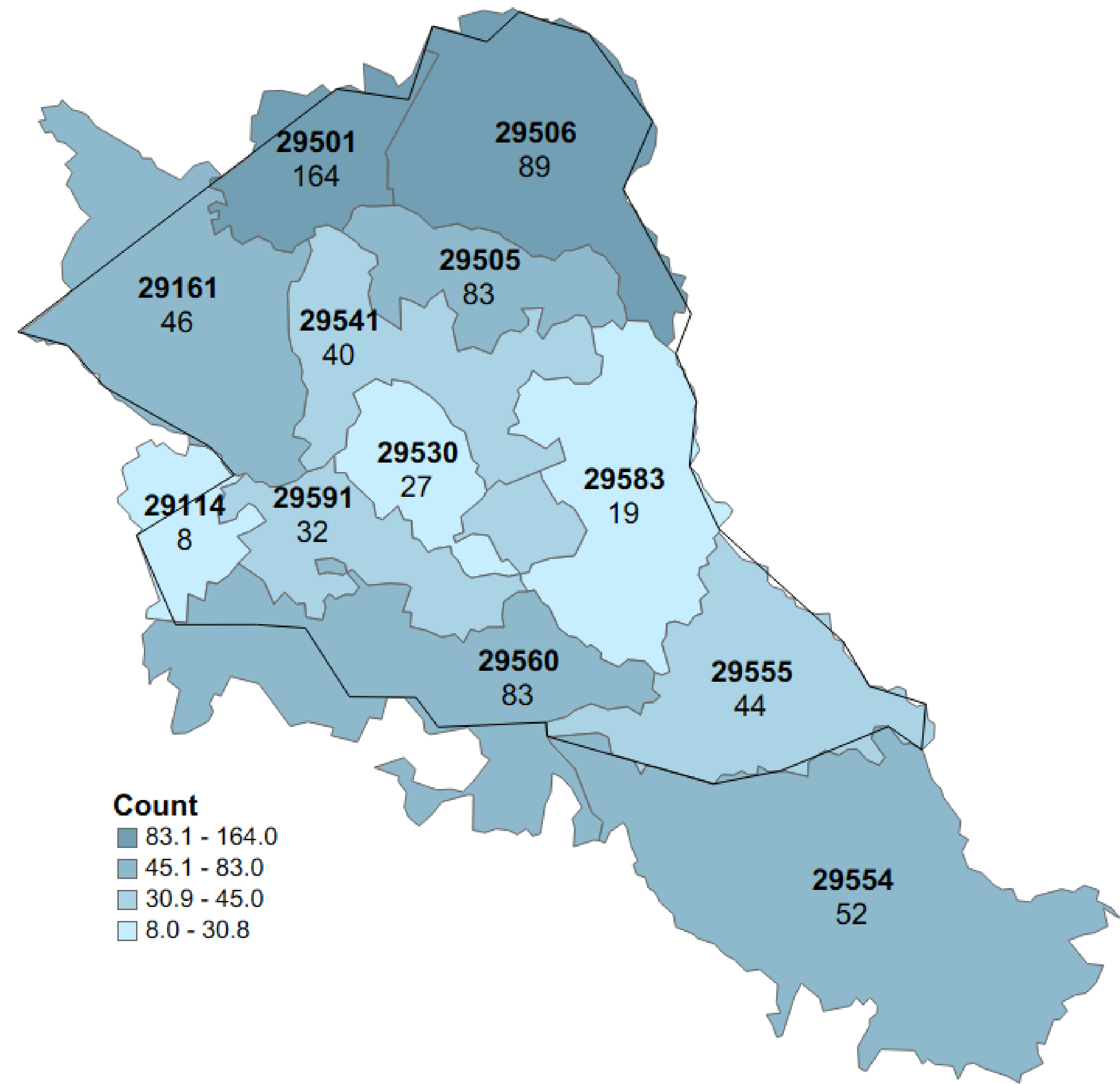

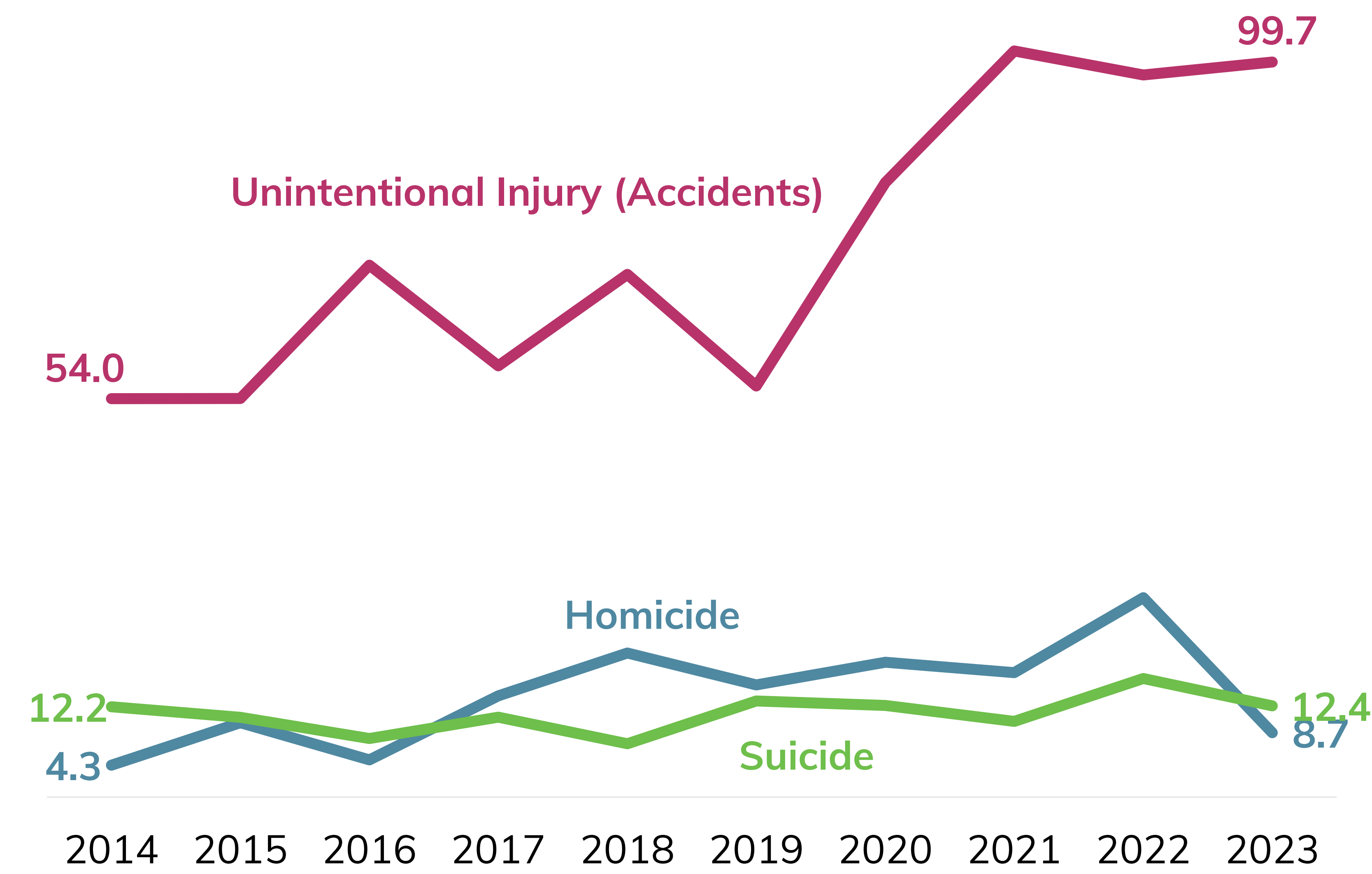

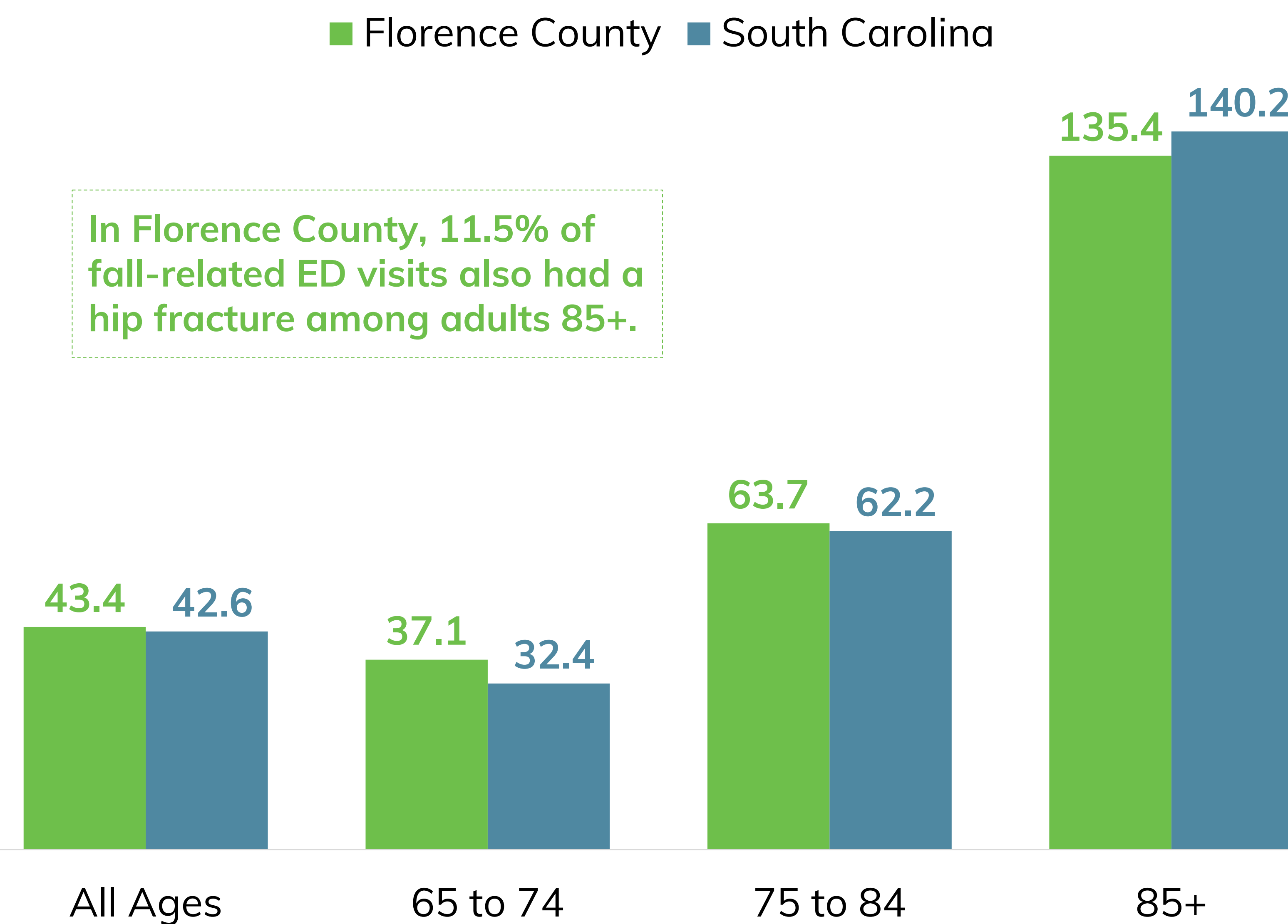
**Leading Cause of Injury Deaths in Florence County, by Age Group**

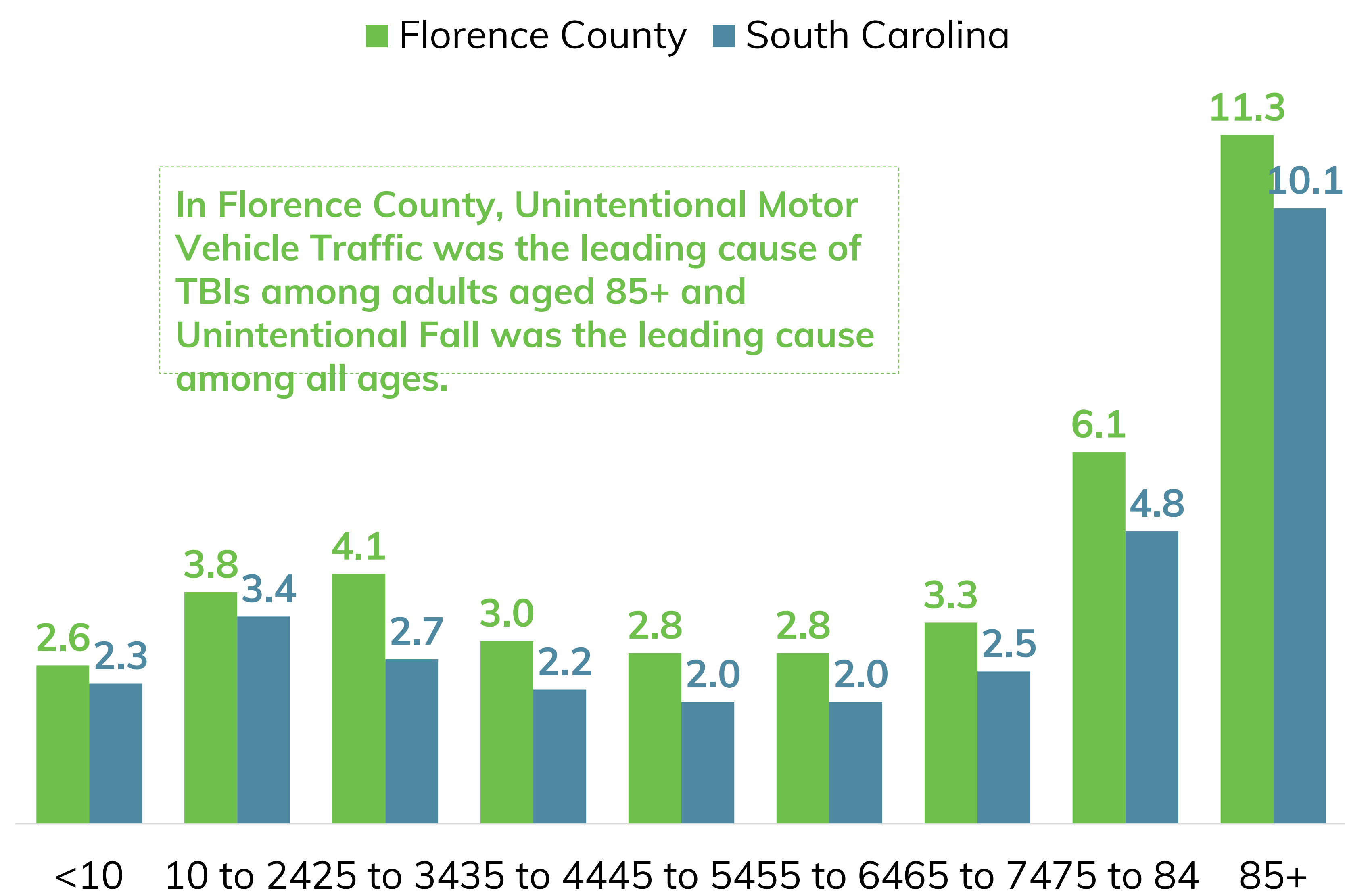
**Fall-Related Emergency Department Visits, by Age Group**

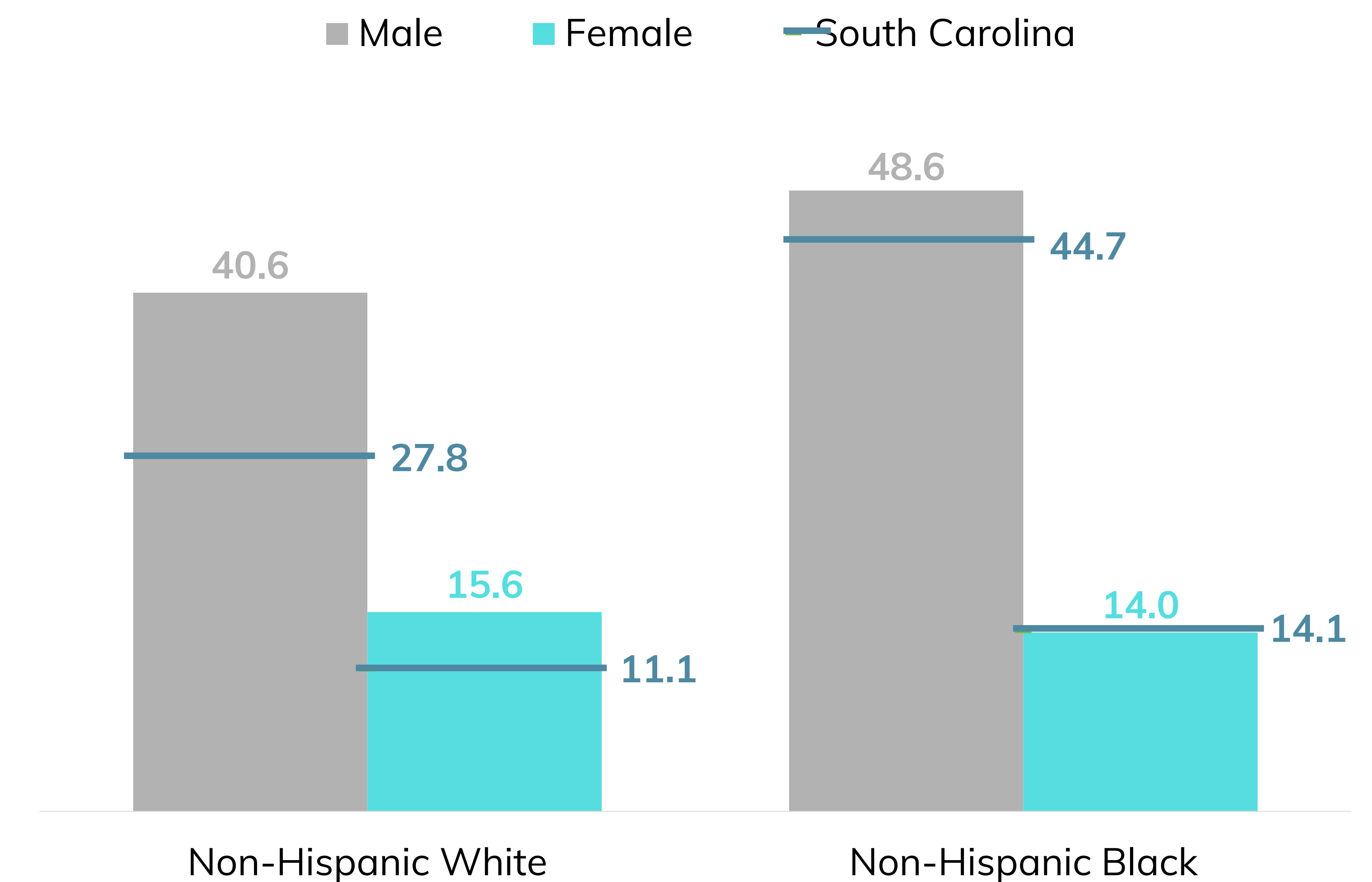
**Traumatic Brain Injury-Related Emergency Department Visits, by Age Group**
