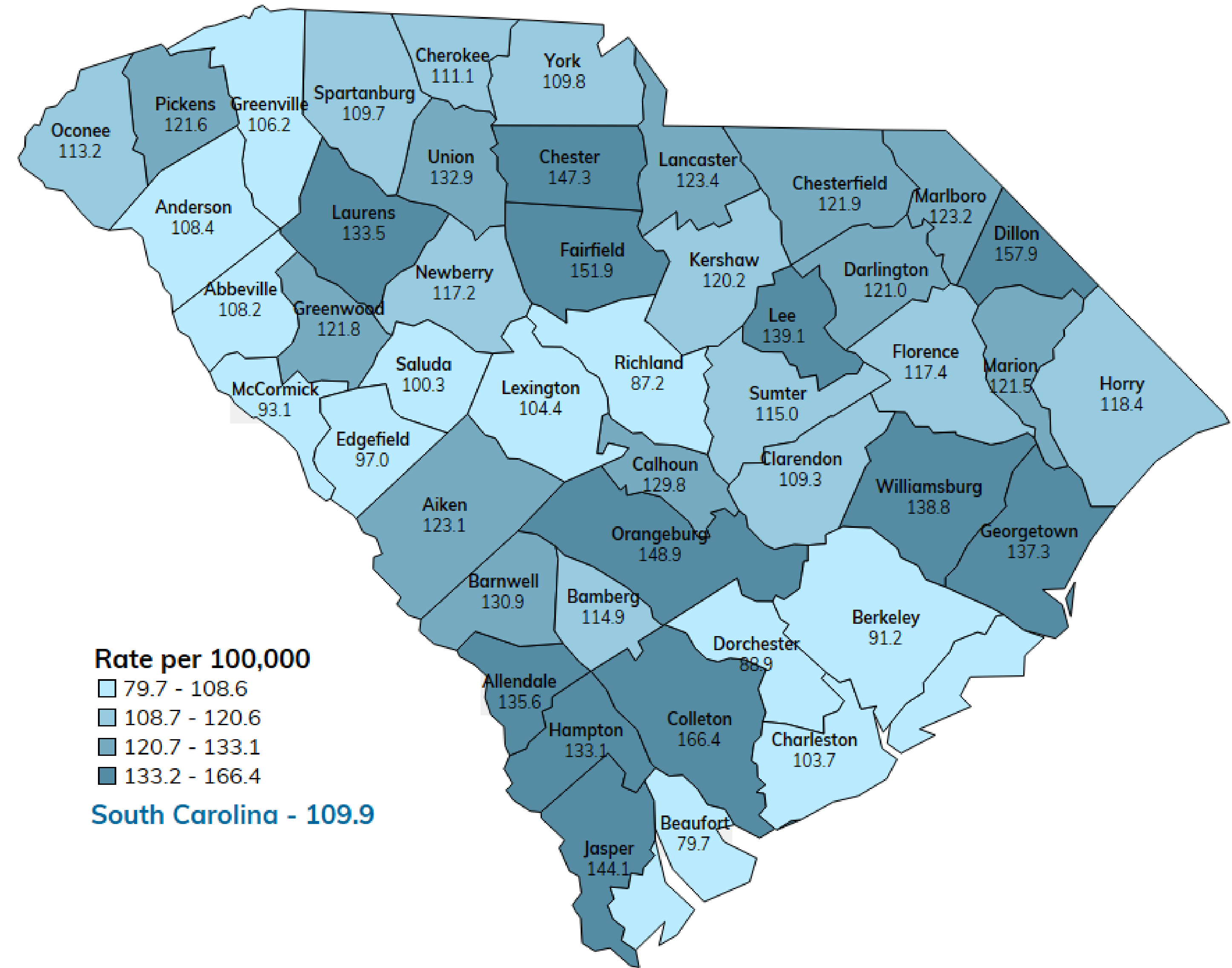


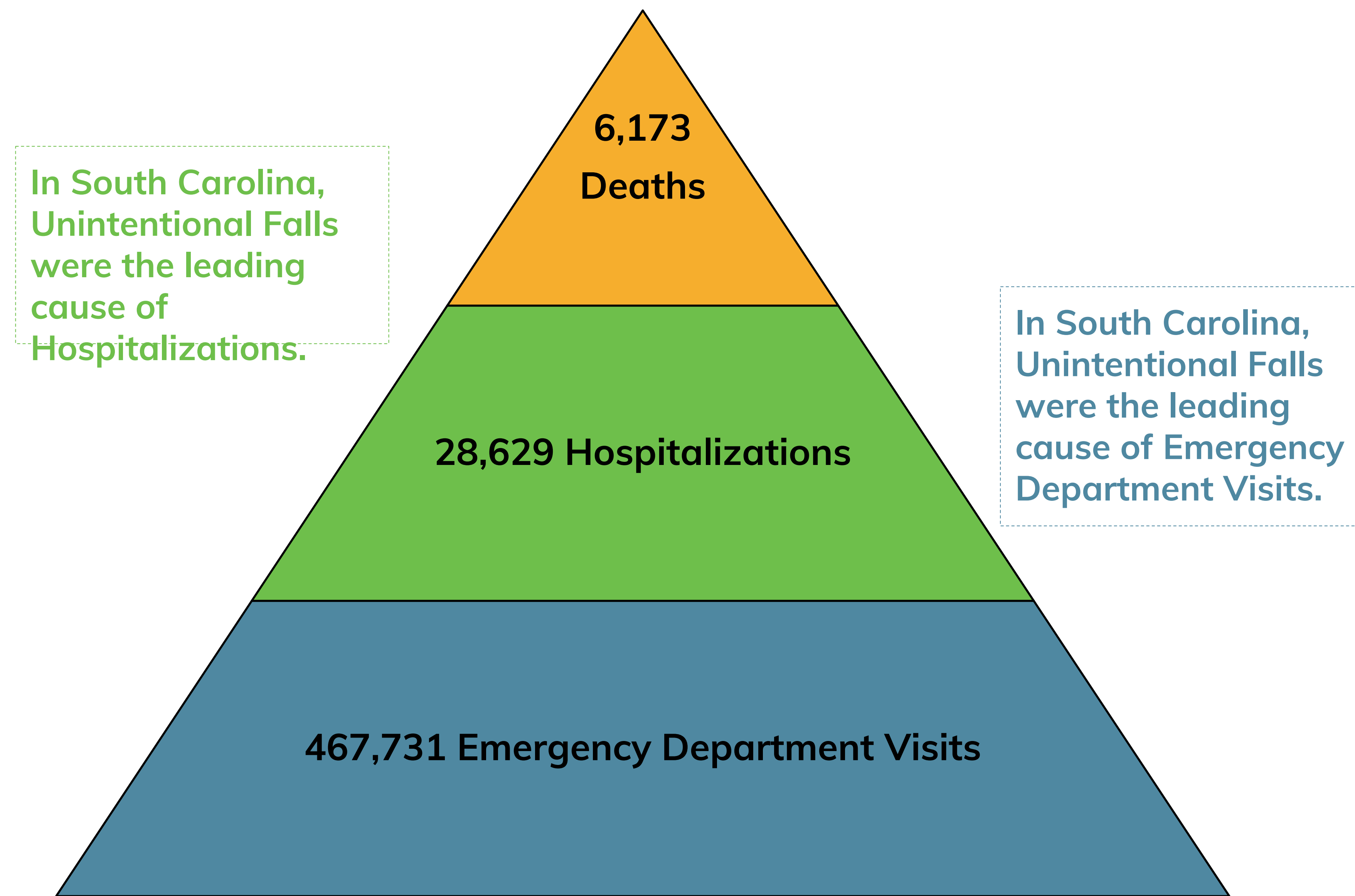

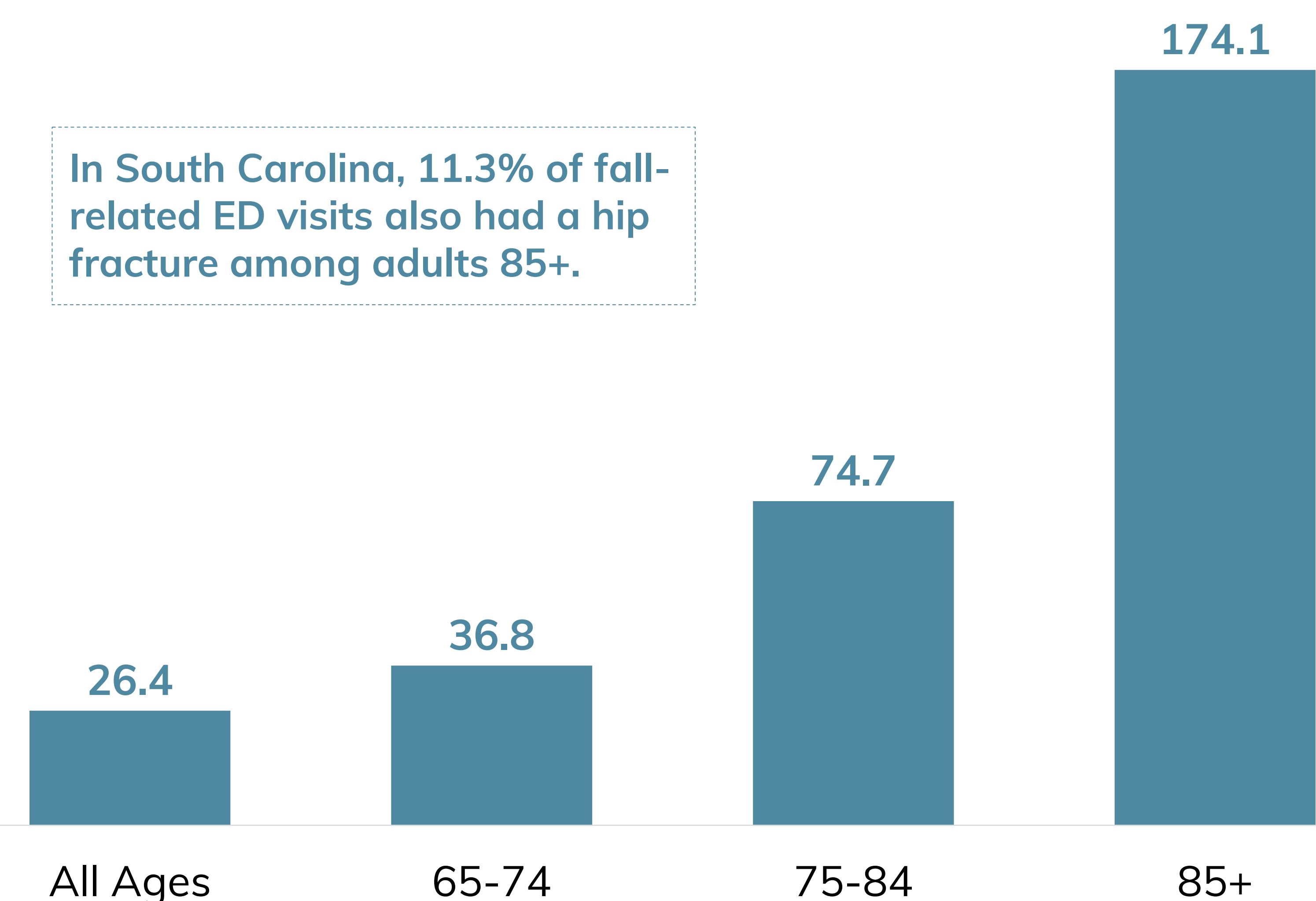

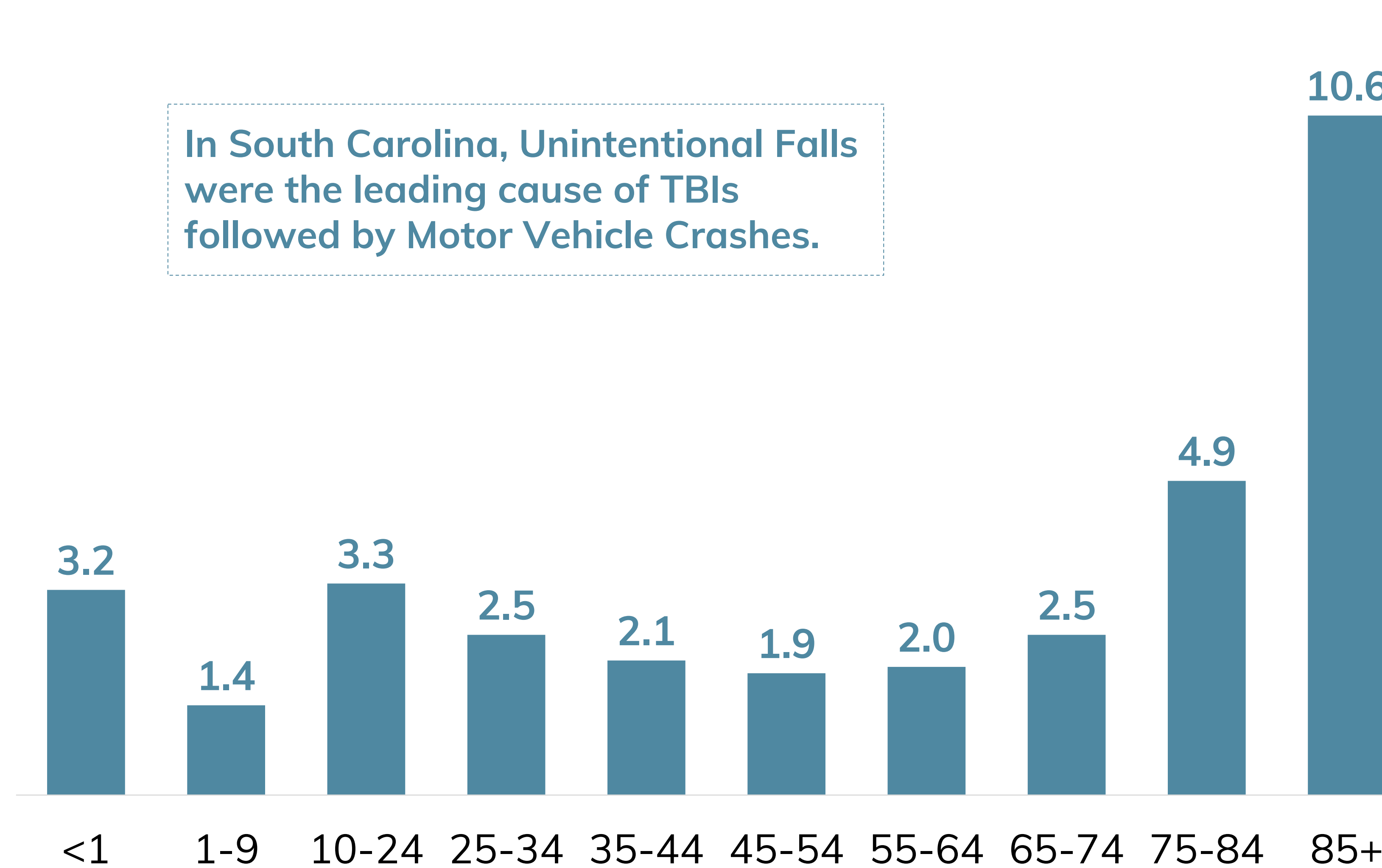

Rate per 1,000 population



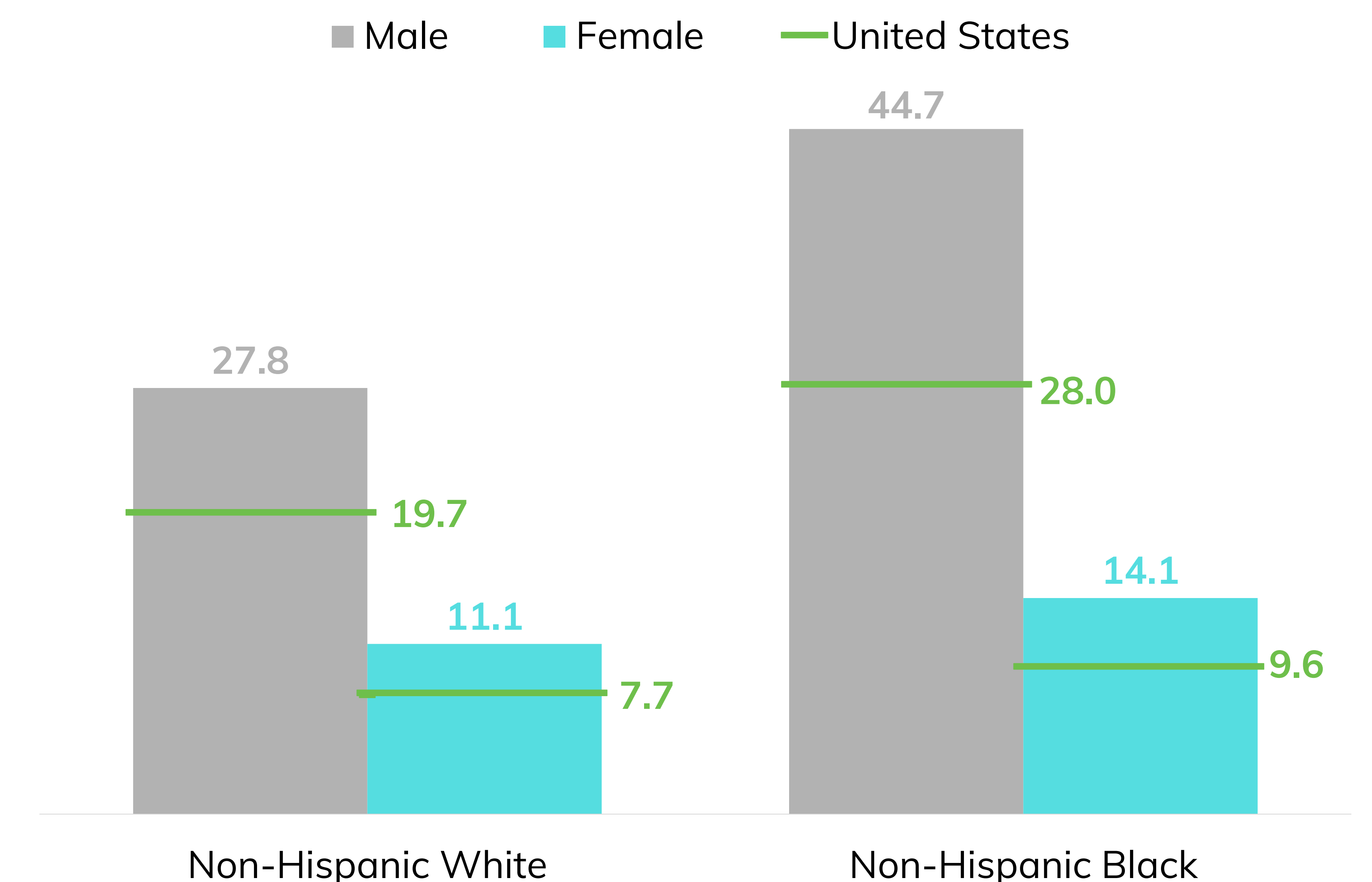
