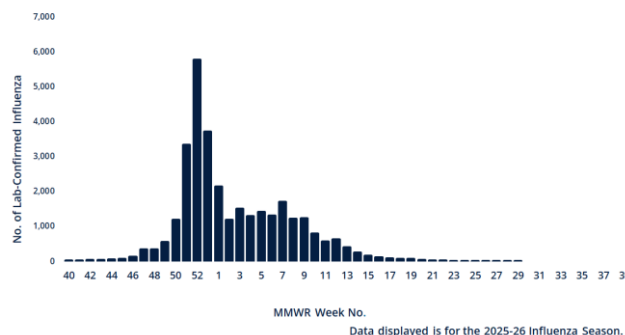

Virologic Surveillance

This week **8** lab-confirmed tests were reported. In the current flu season, there have been **32,148** lab-confirmed tests reported.

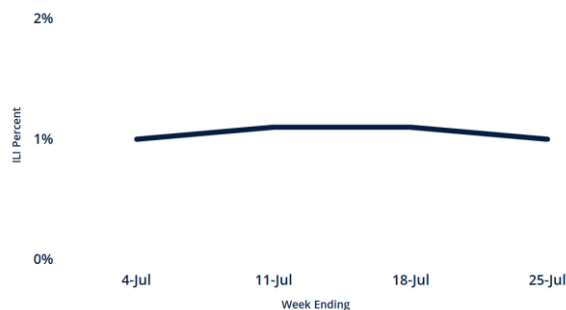


Influenza-Associated Hospitalizations

This week **7** influenza-associated hospitalizations were reported by **58** hospitals. The cumulative hospitalization rate is **97.8 per 100,000**. In the current flu season, there have been **4,968** influenza-associated hospitalizations.

Influenza-Like Illness Surveillance

The percent of patient visits to sentinel providers for an influenza-like illness (ILI) was **1.0%**, which is **below** South Carolina's baseline (**3.2%**). The ILI activity level overall was **minimal**.



Influenza-Associated Deaths

This week, **no** influenza-associated deaths were reported. The cumulative mortality rate is **4.2 per 100,000**. In the current flu season, there have been **211** influenza-associated deaths.
