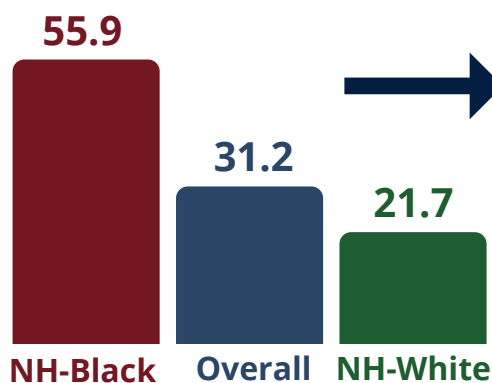


Maternal Mortality in South Carolina

2022-2023

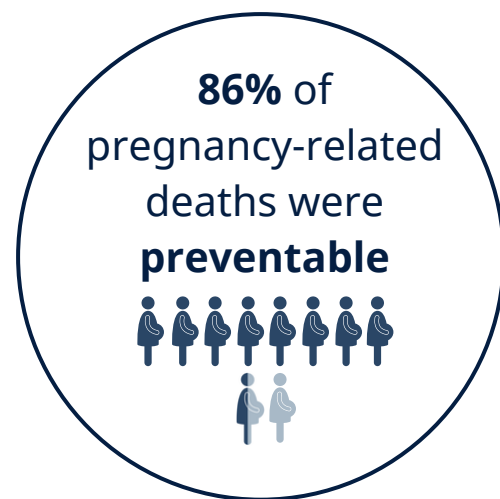


Pregnancy-related deaths **decreased by 38%** from
2021-2023 in South Carolina

The pregnancy-related mortality rate (PRMR) was **~2.5 times higher in Non-Hispanic Black mothers** compared to Non-Hispanic White mothers



Leading Causes of Pregnancy-Related Death in 2022-2023:



Pregnancy-Related Deaths Were Higher in Mothers Who Were:

- Residents of a rural county
- Older than 35 years
- Medicaid beneficiaries
- Receiving inadequate prenatal care

58% of pregnancy-related deaths occurred in the **post-partum period**
