How to Participate

Who is Eligible?

Any business or organization that:

- Has educated its staff about spotting strokes and calling 911
- Actively promotes Stroke Smart awareness in its community

Who Can Apply?

Organizations, businesses and places of employment such as:

- Childcare or day care center
- College or university
- Community/civic organization or nonprofit
- Faith-based organization
- First responders (e.g. police, fire, paramedics, EMS)
- Government entity, local or state
- Health and wellness (e.g. gym, yoga, physical therapy)
- Hotel or motel
- Housing development
- Law enforcement agency
- Library or library system
- Medical practice (dental, primary care, FQHC, urgent care)
- Mental/behavioral health facility
- Nursing home/assisted living
- Outpatient facility (e.g. imaging center, laboratory, dialysis)
- Pharmacy
- Recreation center, YMCA
- Rehabilitation hospital
- Retail (e.g. coffee shop, clothing, supermarket, restaurant)
- School (preschool, K-12, public or private)
- Service organization (e.g. fraternity, sorority, Rotary club, Ruritans, Lion's Club)
- Senior organization (e.g. day center, residence)
- Other workplace (e.g. bank, law office, hair/nail salon, barber)
