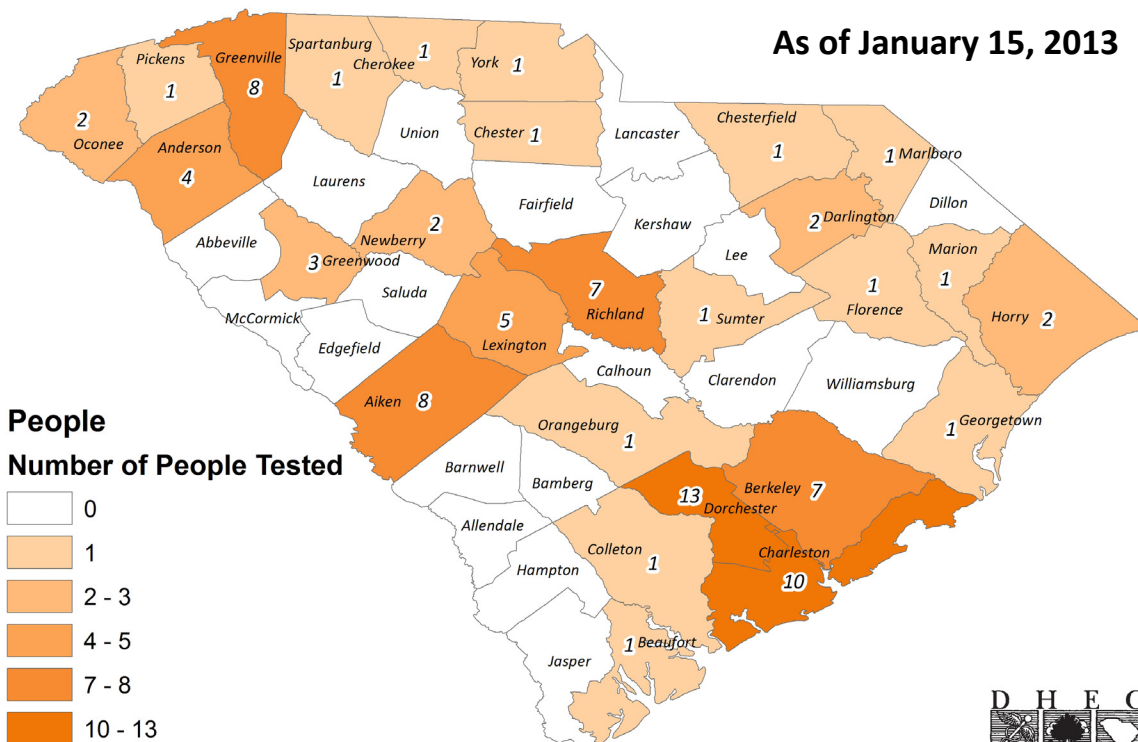

[‡] Clemson University Veterinary Diagnostic Center performs most of the WNV & EEE testing of horses/mammals.

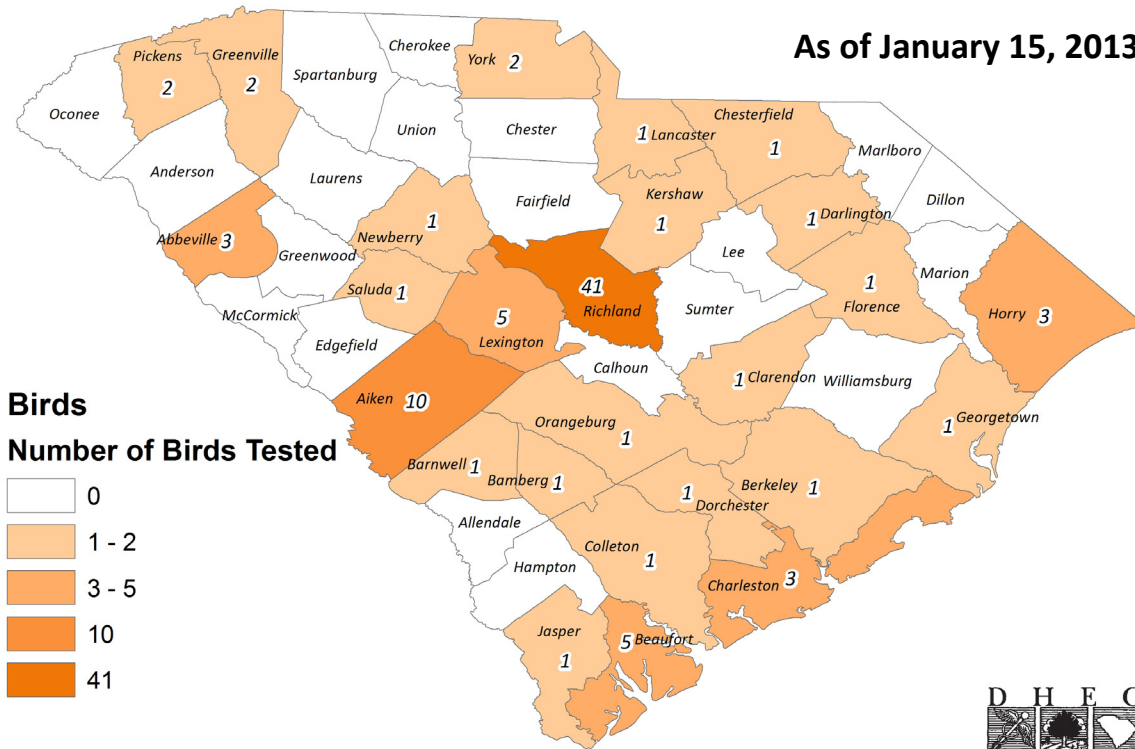

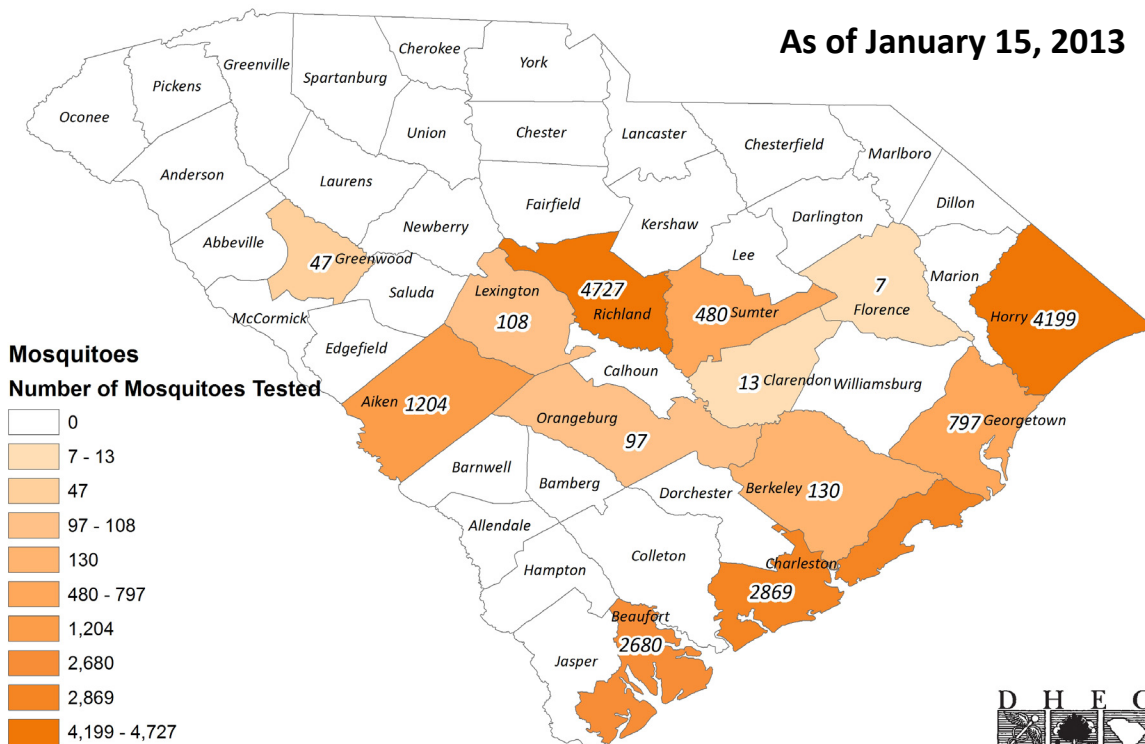

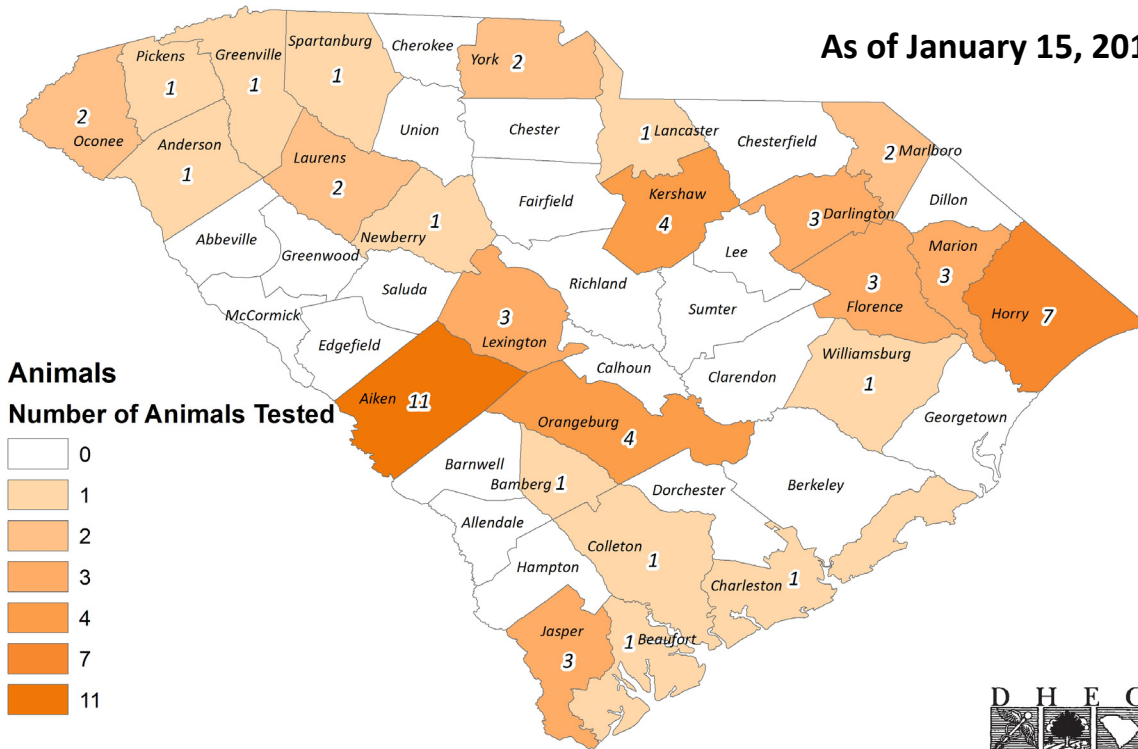
